Working Together to Keep God's Vision

That vision arises out of Jesus' closing charge to his disciples. "Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, *even* to the end of the age" (Matthew 28:19-20).

Our shepherds see certain core values as essential in fulfilling the mission. We must: teach the truth, meet the needs of the needy, be servant minded, love one another and be hospitable. They have set forth six goals to promote our core values and achieve our mission. 1) All members of Siwell Road need to become stronger Christians. 2) We must reach out to our community through teaching and preaching the truth. 3) All of us should stress the nurturing of our children, no matter their ages, to remain faithful in the Lord. 4) Our outreach should extend to those outside of Christ the world over. 5) The physical needs of our church family, other Christians and non-Christians must be met. 6) We need to grow in our relationships within God's family.
