## Jay Berwanger

The Wolverines [Michigan] have three players who have won the Heisman trophy: Tom Harmon (1940), Desmond Howard (1991), and Charles Woodson (1997). John Heisman was the director of the Downtown Athletic Club in New York when he began giving the Heisman trophy, to recognize the best player in college football. He chose sculptor Frank Eliscu to design the trophy.

The trophy is 21" high, stands on a black onyx base, and weighs about 70 pounds. Eliscu originally put a smile on the face of the player but Heisman said football players are fighters. So, Eliscu changed the smile to a snarl. While the model for the trophy was Warren Mulrey from Fordham University, Eliscu also used a picture from a newspaper for the details. The picture was Jay Berwanger from the University of Chicago. Berwanger also happened to be the first recipient of the Heisman trophy!

Nearly every adult recognizes the Heisman trophy, even if he is not a football fan. But you would have to be a history buff to recognize the names Jay Berwanger or Warren Mulrey. Yet, we see them in the Heisman trophy every fall, multiple times.

When all is said and done, it will not matter how many people recognize you and me. Our names might be recorded in the church directory for posterity, perhaps in an obscure newspaper article or some other historical record for some reason. What matters, however, is whether people will remember the Jesus Whom we preach. Will they remember the Jesus Whom we reflected in our lives? When people see us, hear us, experience us, will they see something different? Will they see Jesus in us and be impacted by that experience?

"You are the salt of the earth; but if the salt has become tasteless, how can it be made salty *again*? It is no longer good for anything, except to be thrown out and trampled under foot by men.
