Life Thoughts

Last Saturday was my dad's birthday. He would have been 88 years old. There are many lessons I find as I reflect on his life and passing.

First, dad wanted to serve in the kingdom. His love was proclaiming the word of God. That love drove him to preach the gospel, start two Christian camps, preach sermons for two new works and establish a television program in New Mexico. His lifelong dream was to serve as an elder. He was blessed to do that in the final years of his life. Each of us needs to do all in the Lord's name (Colossians 3:17).

Second, loving, supportive family is a blessing to be treasured. Most Saturdays during my first 25 years of full-time preaching were an opportunity to talk to dad about the Lord's work. His counsel was invaluable. Time spent with dad and mom became more precious after I went to college. Seize every moment with family while they are alive. You will likely long for them once they are gone.

Third, life is fleeting. Live it to the fullest while you still can (James 4:13-17). Dad's death just about a month short of his 70th birthday was a shock. I am now just 4 1/2 years from the full extent of his life. Paul said, "See then that you walk circumspectly, not as fools but as wise, redeeming the time, because the days are evil" (Ephesians 5:15-16). The word "redeeming" literally is "buy up intensely." Time is like a sale that is only on until all the product is gone. Don't go home and think about it too long or the opportunity will pass.
