The Siwell Road family enabled me to join Andy and Dana Dulaney on a mission trip to teach God's word in Fiji. Thank you for all the prayers and the money you gave into the treasury to support this good work.

Andy and I left Jackson on Friday, April 19. We arrived in Fiji Sunday, April 21, having completely missed Saturday because of crossing the international date line. We were able to assemble with the saints in Suva both Sunday morning and evening.

Monday, we participated in a devotional with the staff and students of the Bible Institute at Raiwaqa from 9 to 9:15. I then taught 1 and 2 Thessalonians from 9:15 to 11:45. Lunch was from 11:45 to 12:30. Andy taught New Testament Church from 12:30 to 3 p.m. We followed this same pattern April 22-26 and April 29-May 1. Andy gave his test on May 1 and I finished teaching so my test could be given the morning of May 2.

I taught for the Pacific Islands Bible College April 22-26 and April 29-May 1. I administered a final test on the night of May 1. Twenty-two completed the requirements to receive credit for this class. They are working toward a certificate of completion in PIBC. Many others were present for the class who did not take the test.

Dana visited with and encouraged many of the women at the school and church. It is impossible to explain how valuable the example of a dedicated, godly woman can be to those working and worshiping in places like Fiji.

Rocco and Jason Pierce and their families are the missionaries we support in this good work. The Bible Institute is one of many under the umbrella of the Bear Valley Bible Institute. Men from several island nations around the Pacific are receiving training. Upon completion of two years of intensive studies, they take the gospel back to their homelands. Much good is being done.

Thank you for your loving support. Any good done on this trip is fruit that abounds to your account (Philippians 4:15-17).
