Updates on Evangelism

Here are a few of the new evangelistic efforts starting at Siwell Road. If you are interested in helping in any of these areas please sign up on Sunday, July 18th.

Bookmarks - Bookmarks are a way for each member to keep a list in their Bible of those they would like to have a Bible study with and that they will be making efforts to teach the gospel. Please keep these contacts in your prayers and let the congregation know if there is anyway we can help.

Contact Cards - These cards are desgined to be used by each member to add contacts to the congregational contact list. The cards are located on the evangelism table in the foyer. If one of your personal contacts has something going on in their life that the church could help with by sending cards and praying for them, please turn a contact card in to the box in the foyer. Also if you know anyone interested in a Bible study and you would like help or prayers with that study use these cards to submit names for Bible studies.

Card Care Groups. - The whole congregation will be divided into four groups to write cards to our congregational contact list, visitors, new converts, and members that need encouragement or are erring. Each group will meet once a month on Sunday evenings. Group leaders will be assigned for each group. Groups will be posted on the bulletin board on Sunday morning July 18th.

Door Knockings - One Saturday a month we will have a door knocking where we will try to set up Bible studies and reach out to our community. These door knockings will be assisted by the House to House/Heart to Heart publication we will be sending to our community.

House to House / Heart to Heart - This is an evangelistic news letter that we will be sending out to our community. This publication contains evangelistic materials, articles, and information about the Church.

New Movers - Along with House to House we are starting a ministry to reach people that are new to our community. We are starting a group that will assemble new movers baskets as a way to reach out to those in our area. Greeters/Visitor Bags - As a way to welcome our guests at each of our services we are bringing back a new greeters group. These greeters will be greeting primarily in the auditorium before and after class/worship. One of the tasks of the greeters will be to distribute visitor bags that will be provided.
