Making the Lord My Shepherd

David sang, "The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want" (Psalm 23). His view of God ought to be the view held by all Christians.

Making the Lord my shepherd means listening to his call. Jesus said the sheep hear the voice of the shepherd (John 10:1-3). Peter's words at the temple show the importance of hearing Jesus' instructions. "For Moses truly said to the fathers, 'The Lord your God will raise up for you a Prophet like me from your brethren. Him you shall hear in all things, whatever He says to you. And it shall be that every soul who will not hear that Prophet shall be utterly destroyed from among the people" (Acts 3:22-23).

Christians who hear the shepherd's call will follow his voice, as the Lord went on to say in John 10:4-5. We must be careful not to listen to everyone claiming to speak for the Lord (1 John 4:1). The Savior said the sheep hear his voice and follow him (John 10:27-28). They follow because he is the "the way, the truth, and the life" (John 14:6).

Those who hear Jesus' voice and follow him rely upon him for care. Peter told the scattered Christians of the first century they could cast all their cares on God because "He cares for you" (1 Peter 5:7). The singer of Israel said to trust the Lord because he can bring it to pass (Psalm 37:3-5).

Christ's followers do not need to worry about their basic needs being met if they put God's kingdom first (Matthew 6:25-33). The Lord promised that those who continue to ask, seek and knock will discover their Father in heaven gives them good things (Matthew 7:7-11).

I urge you to not wait another day. Make the Lord your shepherd.

Updates on Evangelism
