## "Missing Man Accidentally Joins His Own Search Party"

The BBC carried this story on Oct 1<sup>st</sup>. It seems Beyhan Mutlu was a wee bit intoxicated on Tuesday and wandered into the Bursa province forest. When he failed to show up his wife alerted local authorities and a search party was sent to find him. The BBC article says "Mr. Mutlu, 50, then stumbled across the search party" and unknowingly joined a search looking for himself! It was not until some of the search party began to yell out his name that Beyhan realized that he was the "lost one" and replied, "I am here!"

We sometimes wonder why the world does not hear the call of the gospel. It may be very similar to Mr Mutlu's story.

First, Beyhan never perceived of himself as being lost. Like the Prodigal in the far country, the lost sometime know exactly where they are and never think of themselves as being lost! Walking in darkness can blind a person from the light and the reality that he or she is the one God is seeking.

Second, Mr Mutlu's heart, despite being a soiled heart, was not a dark heart. He had quickly joined the search to help find someone else. He had a family that cared deeply for him. Much like the rich man, who had Lazarus lying at his gate, being lost is not always characterized by some dark, demonized heart. Some go about normal life never realizing how far his or her heart is from the will of God.

Third, when Beyhan Mutlu heard they were looking for him, his response was immediate. It was very much like the Eunuch when Philip used the gospel to open his eyes. His response was immediate! How many of our lost friends and neighbors resemble in some fashion Mr. Mutlu? If we were bold enough to share the message of Christ, we might hear them say, "I am here Lord. Please save me!"

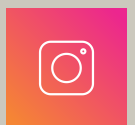

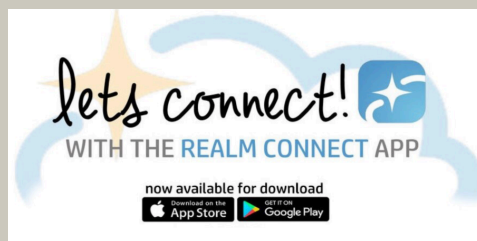
