## **A Family-Run Hospital**

Jesus came into this world to seek and save the lost (Luke 19:10). He wants people to come to Him (Matthew 11:28). Jesus died on the cross for the sins of mankind (Romans 5:8), and He provides the only way to be made free of sin, have our sins washed away, and gain access to the Father (John 14:6, Hebrews 9:14, Acts 22:16, Romans 6:1-4).

When we are baptized into Christ for the remission of our sins Christ cleanses us and He adds us to His Church (Acts 2:38,47). Jesus is the Head of the Church (Colossians 1:18), and has given us numerous examples and commands of how we are to respond to the sick and lost of our world (Matthew 28:19-20). He wants the workers in His Kingdom to study and be ready to preach the Word to the lost (2 Timothy 2:15, 2 Timothy 4:1-5). No matter who we are we too were once lost in sin (Romans 3:23), but now that we have been made whole we are to be workers in the Kingdom. 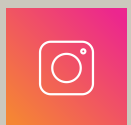
