## **Same Diligence**

In Hebrews 11:6 we see that ". . .without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him." Let us all set as a pattern for our lives to hear and follow sound doctrine, to work and serve God daily, and to have faith that is strong and ready to endure to the end. Let us continue to give the same diligence to God all the days of our life so that one day we can enter into the eternal home in heaven on high.

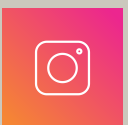
