Fiji Mission Report

On October 21st, Andy and Dana Dulaney, along with myself, traveled to Fiji for a two week mission trip. Our purpose in this trip was to encourage our missionaries who are living and working in Fiji, to help teach at the Bible Institute at Raiwaqa, and to help encourage members of the Lord's Church in Fiji. From the moment we got off the plane until we left to come home we were either teaching or fellowshipping with the brethren. The missionary families working in Fiji are Rocco and Debbie Pierce and Jason and Devan Pierce, along with their sons Caleb and Nathan. These families are doing such an incredible work in Fiji. We spent a good amount of time with these families hoping to be an encouragement to them as they were definitely an encouragement to us. We discussed ministry and the work in Fiji, and these families showered us with so much hospitality. We are so glad we had the opportunity to spend this time with some of our missionaries. It was an encouraging time for all.

While in Fiji, Andy and I taught two different classes over a period of nine days, for the Bible Institute at Raiwaqa. Andy taught a class on the Kingdom parables. This was a great class and the students seemed to learn a lot. I was blessed with the opportunity to teach through 1st Corinthians. The students were very attentive, and they all had a great desire to learn more about God's Word. One of the really great things we were able to take part in with the school was their graduation. Two of their students, a married couple, graduated this year and will soon be moving back to the other side of Fiji to help strengthen and work with a congregation in their home town. This school has helped develop and strengthen so many men and women in Fiji. We are looking forward to everything the future holds for the Bible Institute at Raiwaqa.

On top of teaching for the school we all had opportunities to encourage the Church in Raiwaqa. These brethren welcomed us in like family. It was such a joy to be with them, even if it was just for a couple of weeks. While we were there, Dana had an opportunity to speak to the ladies at a ladies' tea. They all seemed to have a wonderful time of fellowship and study together. Andy and I both had opportunities to teach or preach for the local congregation. Andy taught the first Wednesday night we were there from the book of Ecclesiastes. On our last Sunday with the brethren Andy taught a class about elders and deacons. The local congregation has two elders and hopefully one day soon they will be able to add additional elders and deacons. I was blessed with the opportunity to preach twice for the congregation as well as teach one of the classes on a Wednesday night. This congregation is really active and on fire for the Lord. It is so encouraging to know that we have brethren worldwide that are walking the same walk in the Lord. One of my favorite things I enjoyed from being with the brethren was the singing. It was absolutely beautiful in sound, but the most beautiful part of all was the passion and enthusiasm each member had and expressed while we sang. They truly put their whole heart into their singing and really everything they did. This trip to Fiji was about helping our brethren in another part of the world, but really it helped us all, both our Fijian brethren and those of us that were able to go, to be encouraged to walk a better and more faithful life daily in the Lord. Let us all be encouraged by the faith of these brethren and let us all continue to strive daily to live lives pleasing to our God.



Please keep **Hulon and Annette Parrett** in your prayers as Hulon transitions home and as Annette continues to take care of him.


Update on **Zach Shiers** – he is no longer in a coma. He is still in ICU and still has a long recovery ahead. Continue to keep him in your prayers.


