#### **Portrait of My Life**

One of my favorite books to utilize when doing an Old Testament survey is a book called "Portrait of God" by Frank Chesser. One of the main purposes of this book is to help you see how scripture points to Christ from cover to cover. Brother Chesser in his study does an outstanding job of revealing and highlighting the "Portrait of God" that is so clearly seen in God's Word, but as we look into scripture there is another portrait that I want us to think about. Obviously seeing God's plan of salvation and will for mankind is of utmost importantance, but how does the portrait of my life look in comparrison to the Word of God.

In many ways our lives are like the painting of a portrait. When we are born, we are clean and pure just like a blank canvas. Now there are many people in our world that believe that when a child is born the child is already lost and guilty of sin, but as we look into scripture we do not see a child being born already guilty. Instead, we see children that are made in the image of God (Genesis 1:27), and that are "very good" (Genesis 1:31). As God's "very good" creation, that was made in His image, mankind was not created and is not born with sin. What we were created and born with was free will. Mankind has free will, and with that free will we see in Genesis 3:6 Adam and Eve chose sin. With that choice, sin and its consequences entered the world and had an impact on all of mankind, but we are not guilty of Adam's sin (Rom. 5:12).

Every man, woman, and child, including Jesus has had choices. We paint the portrait of our own lives with the choices we make and the things that we do. The difference between Jesus and the rest of mankind is that Jesus never sinned (2 Corinthians 5:21). His portrait has always been and will always clean and pure. But as for the rest of mankind, we "all have sinned and fallen short of the glory of God." (Romans 3:23). We've sinned and messed up over and over again and the portrait of our life has had plenty of mistakes.

The great thing about God's plan of salvation and will for mankind is that we have an opprtunity through Christ Jesus to have our slate wiped clean (Acts 22:16). In my spare time, especially if I am really stressed, I like to paint. I mostly paint nature scenes and if I am being completely honest I am not very good. Usually after a few minutes of painting and experimenting with different shades and ideas I end up with a mess. I would love to be able to wipe the canvas clean, but I can't. The best that I can do while painting is make sure my paint is smooth, let it completely dry, and try again another day. But in Christ Jesus, the canvas of my life has been wiped cleaned and my sins have been forgiven. Even when I sin again as a Christian I have the opportunity to confess my sins and return to God and "He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness." (1 John 1:9).

It is wonderful to be able to look into God's Word and see the portrait of Him and His plan all the way through it. It is also wonderful to know that as the portrait of my life is being painted I have the choice to choose God, turn from my sin, and have the canvas of my life wiped clean. Let us all strive to paint the portrait of our lives to look like Christ and may we all choose to follow him daily.


