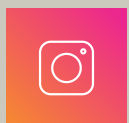

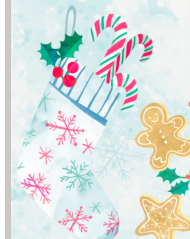
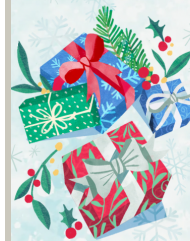

The Bible Contains Fulfilled Prophecy in Detail

(Many thoughts from David Lipe)

- I. The nature of Biblical prophecy.
 - A. "In the Bible prophecy is not an incidental, or accidental, thing" (Batsell Barrett Baxter *I Believe Because...*: 187)
 - B. The prophet was God's messenger—forth telling (proclaiming God's will) and foretelling (predicting future events)
- II. Fulfilled prophecy proves the Bible came from the mind of God.
 - A. 2 Peter 1:19-21
 - B. Isa 41:22-23a
 - C. Isaiah 46:9-10
- III. The formal argument for predictive prophecy.
 - A. If the Bible is characterized by predictive prophecy that is beyond human production and is later fulfilled, then the Bible is the inspired word of God.
 - B. The Bible is characterized by predictive prophecy that is beyond human production and is later fulfilled.
 - C. Therefore, the Bible is the inspired word of God
- IV. Characteristics of predictive prophecy.
 - A. It is more than a good guess
 - B. It is not vague generalizations
 - C. It deals with events and states of affairs that are not logically necessary
 - D. The fulfillment of predictive prophecy must be clear and not ambiguous
 - E. It must be remote

- VI. Isaiah's prophecy is one of true prediction.
 - A. Exultation of the Servant—52:13-15
 - B. Rejection of the Servant—53:1-3
 - C. Vicarious sacrifice of the Servant—53:4-6
 - D. Humiliation of the Servant—53:7-9
 - E. Glorification of the Servant—53:10-12
- VII. Jesus fulfilled Isaiah's prophecy.
 - A. His birth and appearance not special
 - B. He would be rejected by his own people
 - C. His trials would be a sham
 - D. His suffering would be immense and unjust
 - E. He would refuse to retaliate
 - F. His sacrifice would be substitutionary
 - G. Associated with wicked men in his death
 - H. He would be buried in a rich man's tomb
 - I. He would be highly exalted after ward
