"Busy and Distracted" (An Article by John Allan)

I've read Exodus before. Several times. But I'm not sure Exodus 5:8 ever stuck out to me the way it did yesterday when I read it as part of our Bible reading schedule. In context, this is when the Pharaoh who arose and "did not know Joseph" (see Exodus 1:8) rejected Moses and Aaron's request that Israel go hold a feast to God in the wilderness. After that rejection, Pharaoh told his taskmasters to make work more difficult for Israel: they would have to gather straw themselves and still make the same quota of bricks they already had.

Why? "And you shall lay on them the quota of bricks which they made before. You shall not reduce it. For they are idle; therefore they cry out, saying, 'Let us go and sacrifice to our God.'" (Exodus 5:8; NKJV)

Pharaoh seemed to believe if Israel stayed busy working, they wouldn't have time to think about God, or desire to serve God. And to be fair, it seems like most often that's exactly what happens when people get too busy for their own good: their dedication to God goes by the wayside.

What that means for us is we need to be careful not to let ourselves get so busy we lose sight of God. If Pharaoh thought people could be made so busy they wouldn't think of God, it's an idea that's probably crossed Satan's mind too.
